Member and Elder, Upper Skagit Indian Tribe

Scott Schuyler is a descendant of Pateaus Sub Chief of the Upper Skagit Tribe, who signed the Treaty of Point Elliot with the United States in 1855. Scott has fished, hunted, and gathered for the last 40 years just as his ancestors did in the Upper Skagit. Currently, he is employed by the Upper Skagit Tribe as the Policy Representative for Natural & Cultural Resources. He has been the lead negotiator for the Tribe for fish & wildlife issues since 1994 and hydropower relicensing in the Skagit since 2002.
